PRESENTATION

Terroir Daronton - named after its founders - delivers the finest expression of Rhone Valley

Each cuvée is a blend of grape varieties and soils, selected for their ability to deliver the most accurate expression of its appellation.

Vines are located in the "La Ponche" and "Garrigue" sectors. Soils of blue clay and limestone.

VINIFICATION

Harvest at optimum maturity. Short maceration of 15-18 days. Fermentation at controlled temperature (26-27°C). Daily pumping-over.

Grenache noir 58%, Syrah 34%, Mourvèdre Production volume: 4000 hL 6%, Carignan 1%, Cinsault 1%

SERVING

16-18°C

Intense nose of wild strawberries and blueberries. Fruity and beautifully balanced with a mineral quality. Long liquorice final.
