PRESENTATION

Terroir Daronton - named after its founders - delivers the finest expression of Rhone Valley wines.

Each cuvée is a blend of grape varieties and soils, selected for their ability to deliver the most accurate expression of its appellation. "Special Editions" are partly oak aged. More complex, the wines will also have a longer ageing capacity.

TERROIR

Grapes are grown in the "Plan de Dieu" (plain of God) since the Middle Age. Here, Grenache and Syrah grapes grow on limestone, round pebbles and alluvial soils.

WINEMAKING

Grapes are harvested at optimum maturity, then destemmed and crushed. Traditional vinification at controlled temp. Maceration lasts around 20 days.

Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre

TASTING

Nos of red fruits, spices and "garrigue". Round and large, with elegant tannins as well as spicy flavours and a beautiful liquorice final.
