Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre

### 13,5 % VOL.

Contains sulphites.

### SERVING

16-18°C

A deep color that opens with notes of intense black fruits. A velvety mouth sublimates aromas of blackberries and cocoa with a long and greedy finish.
