PRESENTATION

1985, Chavany: since his graduation from wine school, Marc Rouvière has been looking for a domain to take over. With his wife, Dominique, they looked at the Beaujolais region but opportunities were rare. When Marc's uncle took them to the Chavanay wine market, they fell in love with the area and heard about a property on sale. Renovation of the old building, restoration of the vineyards and the winery: on the steep hillsides of Condrieu, the family estate was born! Marc later learned that the name "Rouvière" means "a place covered with oak trees"!

In 2012, their children, Anaïs and Julien joined the family business. The estate has been certified "High Environmental Value" since 2020.

Granitic soil south oriented - Lieu-dit "les Eguets et les Rivoires"

WINEMAKING

Traditional fermentation in stainless steel vats. Then 50% of the cuvée is put in oak barrels for final fermentation and a 6-months ageing.
