PRESENTATION

Located on the southern slopes of the Costières de Nimes area, facing the Camargue & the Mediterranean see, the property was created by monks in the 12th century. After the French Revolution, the Castillon family bought the estate and still owns the property nowadays. The vineyard is Organic certified and has started to convert towards biodynamic viticulture.

LOCATION

The vineyard benefits from a southern exposure. During the summer, the sea breeze preserves the freshness of the wines and increases the aromatic palette of the grape varieties.

TERROIR

Pebbles from the Quaternary era.

WINEMAKING

Grapes are harvested at the coolest hours of the day. After cold maceration during 3 days, the fermentation undergoes at controlled temperatures.

VARIETALS

Mourvèdre 40%, Grenache noir 30%, Syrah 30%

SERVING

16-18°C

TASTING

Garnet color. Notes of red fruit, spice and liquorice. Long and fresh mouth with soft tannins.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Red meat (prime rib, lamb chop with Provence herbs), small game birds, farm cheese.
