



Terroir Daronton, Gigondas, Rouge, 2021

AOC Gigondas, Vallée du Rhône, France

PRESENTATION

Originating from 13 names... those of the thirteen founders who came together and gathered a team of expert winemakers to create a trusted signature for Rhone Valley wines. As a tribute to their work, the name DARONTON was born from a blend of parts of their names.

THE VINTAGE

This year's climatic events have upset the work of our winegrowers. Frost, hail & rains did not spare the region. This vintage will be remembered for being atypical, but also for resulting in qualitative, fresh, lush and tasty wines with limited volumes.

TERROIR

Vines are located in the Grand Montmirail, Prébayon and Col du Cayron areas. Soils are made of clay, limestone and sandstones up to 500m high.

WINEMAKING

Harvest at optimum maturity. Pumping-over at the beginning of the fermentation. Long vatting (20/25 days min.) at controlled temperatures (27-30°C).

VARIETALS

Grenache 60%, Syrah 40%

SERVING

14-16°C

TASTING

Dark red color. Complex and rich nose of red fruits, spices and undergrowth. Velvety on the mouth with aromas of ripe red fruits and soft spices.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Red meat, roasted vegetables and aromatic cheeses.
